

As a group we have been able to host two events in the town this year held in the public hall: a concert and testimony evening with students from our Bible school in Geneva and a two day exhibition and conference marking the 500th anniversary of Jean Calvin. In the next few weeks we will organise 2 other events for Christmas in English and then in French.

Our concern is that new people would become Christians but we find quite a lot of time and energy taken up on issues arising from those who have been in other forms of Christian church practice – this needs prayer.

Christian continues his involvement with young teenagers at the family camp in Brittany – two of the young people gave their lives to God last summer.

A new students group was set up this year run by our colleague Mike and at Easter next year, Christian will accompany some of them to a youth event in Geneva. Catherine has been able to set up a small teenagers group with the church in Angers. She also organised for training for the children's ministry leaders with the French branch of Child Evangelism Fellowship.
